
What is Sage Intacct Planning?

- Complimentary budget application to Sage Intacct.
- Simplified approach to budgeting.
- A look and feel of its own.
- Has its own set of users and permissions separate from Sage Intacct.
- Integrates with Sage Intacct via API.





The Big Picture







Budget Lifecycle

Create plan

- Create plan using company and actuals data
- Add calculations and business drivers
- Review and share with team members
- Export final plan to Sage Intacct

Use in Sage Intacct

- Analyze actuals versus pan using direct links
- Use in reports and spend management

Update a Plan

- Import actuals from Sage Intacct
- Update plan data
- Save plan as forecast
- Export updated plan to Sage Intacct





User Types



Creator: ability to create new budgets



Contributor: ability to add to existing budgets



Viewer: only view budget but cannot make changes to existing budgets





Accessing Sage Intacct Planning:







Access is attached to the users email address




Partners will have access to multiple customers budgets in a single ungrouped listing





Budget Export to Sage Intacct

- Export budgets to an existing budget container in Sage Intacct with ability to Replace or Add to.
- Export budget to a brandnew budget container.
- Export to Top Level, specific entity, or to a consolidated budget.

Budget Structure

- Choose dimension values used for budgeting.
- Determine dimension hierarchy in budget structure.
- Four dimensions can be added to budget structure.
- Keep it simple.








Budget Creation


- Ability to bring in information from additional books (GAAP, user-defined, etc)
- Remove irrelevant budget levels and lines to reduce budget lines
 - Including Revenue, Cost of Revenue, Operating Expenses and Other Income and Expenses
- Consider breaking up the budget into smaller budgets that are combined into a singular budget in Intacct

Utilize Models and Scenarios



Models & Scenarios: The Sage Intacct Planning Difference

 Driver-based modeling: create flexible models based on key business drivers like revenue, headcount, or square footage that can be quickly adjusted as business conditions change.


 Scenario planning: create multiple scenarios based on different assumptions, such as best-case, worst-case, or most-likely scenarios.

Enables finance teams to evaluate the potential impact of different business decisions

and make more informed decisions.
