Order Entry

Sales Order, Sales Invoice, Pledge Receivable Only integrate with opportunity object

Journal Entry

Donations, Pledge, Gift, etc... Integrate with all objects including custom objects

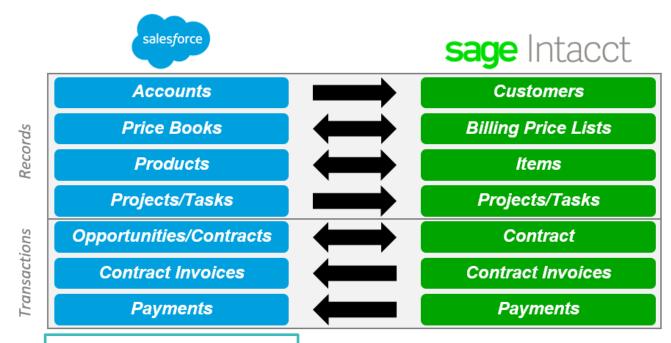
Contract

Work with Intacct Contract module Only integrate with opportunity object

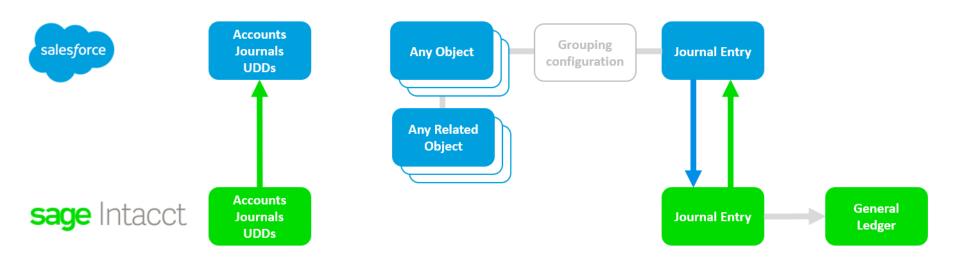

In Intacct navigate to Company > Admin > Subscriptions > Configure Advanced CRM

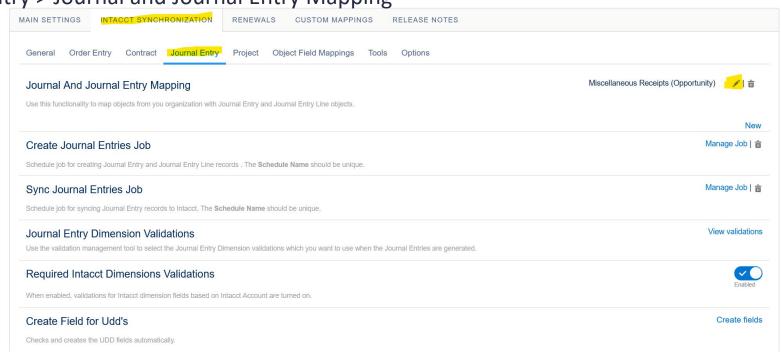






Build – Salesforce Side

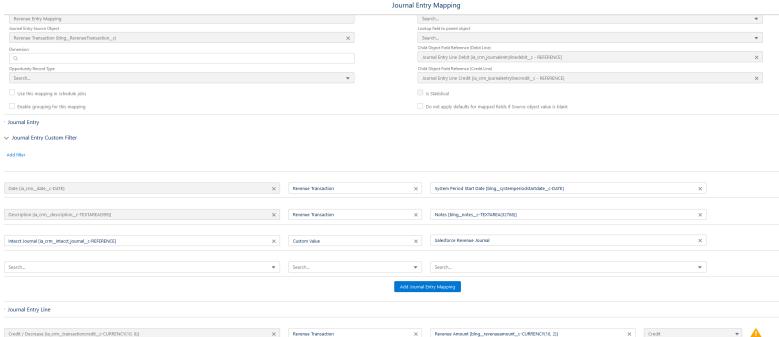
In Salesforce navigate to Intacct Configuration > Intacct Synchronization > Journal Entry > Journal and Journal Entry Mapping









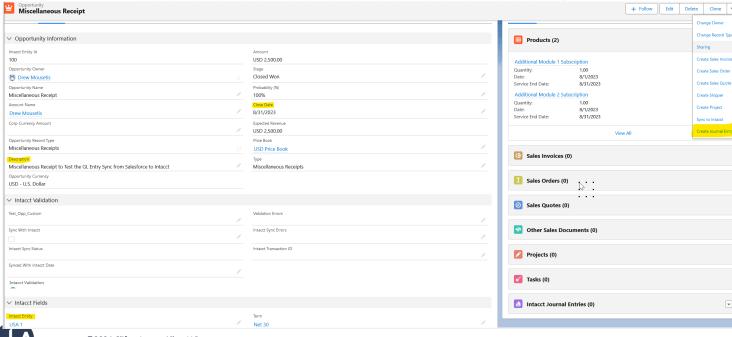






Create Salesforce Journal Entry





- Go to the Salesforce
 Object used in the GL entry mapping
- Ensure fields are completed for required field mappings
- Click "Create Journal Entry" button

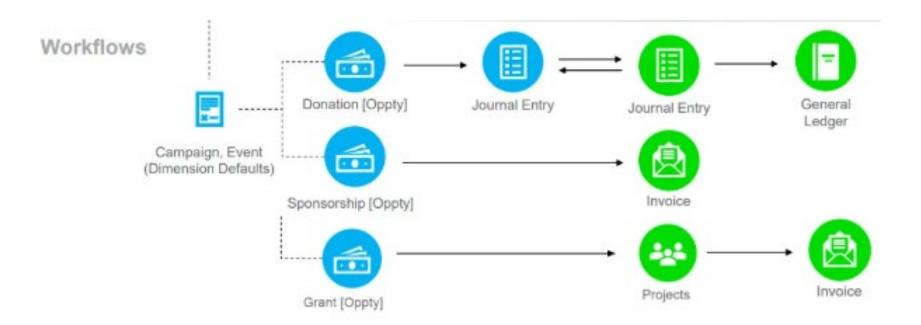

Note: Changes to the Journal Entry in Intacct will sync back to Salesforce in the "Sync Back" (SB) fields.





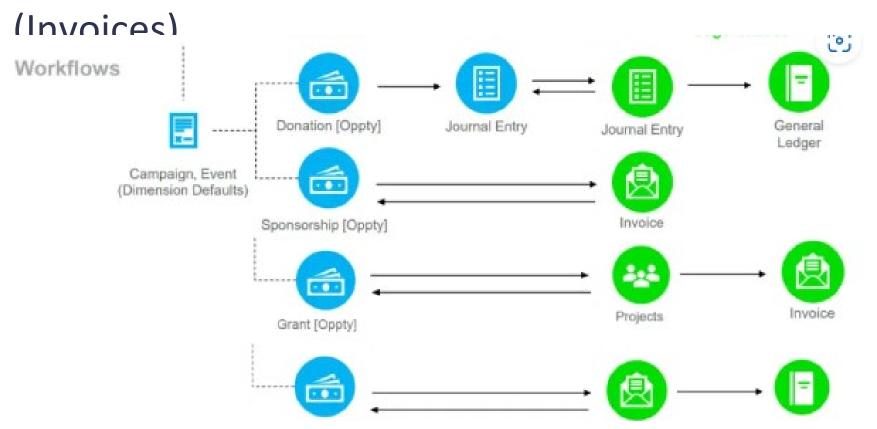
Advanced CRM Workflow for Nonprofits (Donations)







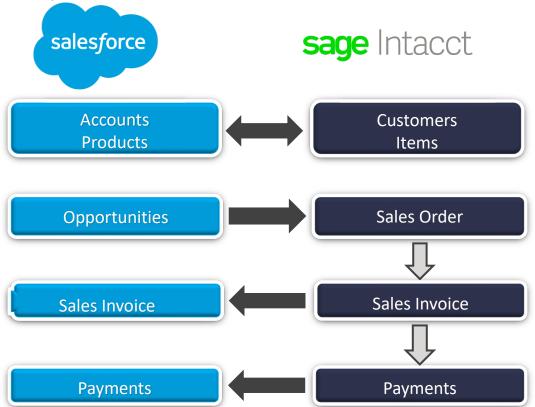
Advanced CRM Workflow for Nonprofits







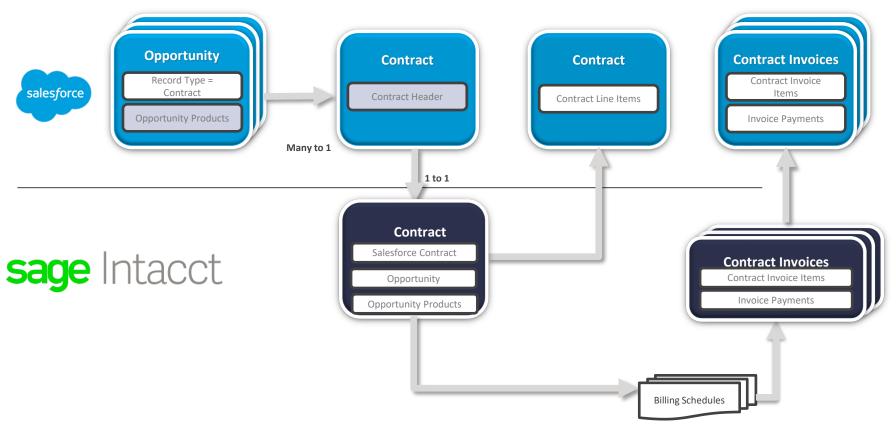
Order Entry Build and Workflow

Benefits of Intacct and SalesForce Automation



Create a Project from a Template

Currently Intacct does not support "templates" for Projects

Work-around

- Intacct: Leveraging Project Status or Project Type to restrict any actions
- Salesforce: Add "Is Template" field to the project page layout
 - When the "Is Template" field is checked, the Project appears in the project template ID dropdown on the Opportunity

* If Tasks are included in the Project template, these will be created in SF after Project is synced to Intacct





Projects and Tasks in Salesforce

Now you can manage your Projects and Tasks from inside Salesforce

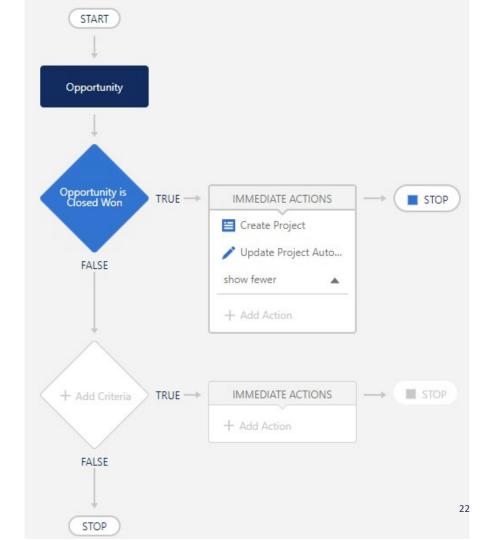
- Project record fields now sync bidirectionally.
- You're now able to create Tasks in Salesforce and sync them with Intacct.

Please note: Formula fields such as Calculated percent complete are still only synced from Intacct to Salesforce because those formulas are derived by Intacct.
